Key Area of Learning
Speaking and Listening

Through learning about the Incas and the Mayans, we will find out about the history of chocolate and create our own chocolate delights and create an advertising campaign.

ENGLISH

Our English will be taught through novel study. This term, our novel will be 'Trash' by Andy Mulligan. We will explore character, setting and the themes which occur throughout the book and use the novel for our writing topics. Our grammar work will be taught alongside these. As well as comprehension through the novel, Guided Reading will develop children's reading skills.

YEAR 5 MATHS

This term, our maths learning will include fractions, decimals and percentages and the connections between them. Children will draw on previous learning to develop their understanding and apply to reasoning problems.

YEAR 6 MATHS

Maths will focus on fractions, decimals and percentages to consolidate and develop connections between them. Also, algebra and measure including perimeter, area and volume. Reasoning and problem solving will support work towards SATs.

SCIENCE

Our topic this term is Light. We will investigate how light behaves and plan and carry out fair tests to answer our questions.

ART/DT

Linked to our topic, we will be designing and making a chocolate bar and creating packaging for it.

COMPUTING

We will create an advertisement for our chocolate bar using IT and develop our editing skills to produce a final film.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

This term, we will explore our big question: What difference does the resurrection make for Christians?

PSHE

'Rights and Responsibilities': how we contribute to change and make a difference and exploring democracy in our country.

GEOGRAPHY

We will learn about where in the world cocoa beans are grown for chocolate and the climates of these locations.

MUSIC

Our Charanga topic this term is 'Benjamin Britten - A Tragic Story' where we will learn about blues and traditional jazz.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

FRENCH
