<b>Curriculum focus of PPG spending 2012/13</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• To increase the percentage of children eligible for FSM to progress 4 points over the year in Numeracy.</li><li>• To increase the percentage of children eligible for FSM to progress 4 points over the year in Literacy.</li><li>• To ensure FSM children achieve the phonics end of year pass mark.</li><li>• To develop children's self-esteem and speaking and listening skills.</li></ul>
